Explanation of Responses:

- Represents AIG's share price on the date of grant; these securities do not carry a conversion or exercise price.
- Represents the payment in cash of \$45,045.80, net of applicable taxes, in settlement of stock salary based on AIG's share price on June 11, 2010. The settlement date for this award was accelerated by one year after certification to the Special Master for TARP Executive Compensation that AIG had completed a corporate transaction that resulted in a repayment to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York.
- These securities do not have an exercisable date or expiration date.
- These securities do not carry a conversion or exercise price.
- This award represents the portion of a grant of fully vested LPTUs that is based on the value of common stock, net of the value of 25,9116 shares withheld for taxes. The LPTUs are based on a mix of common stock and AIG's 8.175% Series A-6 Junior Subordinated Debentures (the "Hybrid Securities"), and represent 20 percent common stock and 80 percent Hybrid Securities, by value, on the date of grant. One third of the award will be payable in cash based on the values of the underlying securities on the first anniversary of the grant date, one third based on the values on the second anniversary and one third based on the values on the third anniversary. The Reporting Person disclaims that the reported portion of the LPTUs is a "derivative security" required to be reported under Section 16 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.
