This award reflects 6,484.2209 shares less the 170.0036 shares withheld for taxes.

3. These securities do not have an exercisable date or expiration date.

4. These securities do not carry a conversion or exercise price.

5. Represents the payment in cash of an aggregate amount of \$81,519.66, net of applicable taxes, in settlement of fully vested LTPUs (both the portion originally granted as common stock and the hybrid portion converted into common stock on April 14, 2011).

6. Represents the payment in cash of \$39,806.72, net of applicable taxes, in settlement of stock salary based on AIG's share price on May 16, 2011. The settlement date for this award was accelerated by one year after certification to the Special Master for TARP Executive Compensation that AIG had completed a corporate transaction that resulted in a repayment to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York.
